- 1) Speeding 6-10 mph over the limit 40 violations
- 2)Lane Restriction Violation 23 violations
- 3) Fail to obey traffic control device 22 violations

Hours of Service

- 1) Failing to certify logs 18 violations
- 2) Failing to manually enter shipping document information 10 violations
- 3) General Form and Manner (failing to add shipping info and/or trailer #) 8 violations

Maintenance

- 1) Flat tire/audible air 44 violations
- 2) Brakes out of adjustment 22 violations
- 3) Tires all other, leaking or inflation less than 50% of max 15 violations
